TEAMS



The Virginia men's and women's squash teams compete at the intercollegiate level as full members of the College Squash Association. Both teams play an extensive schedule of matches during the winter season and travel to the CSA National Team Tournaments, college

squash's culminating events, in mid to late February. Team members also compete individually in CSA Individual Nationals and in US Squash-sanctioned events.

In 2012-2013, the women's team finished with a national ranking of #26, placing them first among club teams. The men's team finished at #36 overall, and seventh among club teams. Virginia squash players also earned a number

of individual accolades during the '12-'13 campaign, including two scholar-athlete awards, one CSA player-of-the-week selection, and a Virginia State Open title in the men's 3.5 division (by women's team co-captain Celia Dyer).

FACILITY

The McArthur Squash Center is a brand new, state-of-the-art, LEED certified facility featuring eight singles courts, one all-glass exhibition center court, and two hardball doubles courts. By any measure, the MSC ranks among the finest squash venues in the world. In addition to providing a new home for the Virginia squash teams, the 33,000-square-foot facility will also provide a gateway for the sport's expansion into the Southeast. The facility will be available to U.Va. faculty, staff and students through the Department of Intramural-Recreational Sports, as well as to members of the Boar's Head Sports Club and guests of the Boar's Head Inn.



COACHING STAFF



Mark Allen is an internationally renowned player and coach, whose credentials include a former top 50 world ranking and certification as an England Squash Level 4 Elite Coach (the highest coaching qualification in English squash). During a professional squash career over 20 years long, Allen has coached all around the world. He was nominated by US Squash to the National Olympic Committee as the 2005 National Coach of the Year and was named the South African Coach of the Year in 2010. In addition to coaching the squash teams at the University of Virginia, Allen is also Director of Squash at The Boars Head Sports Club.

Mark is joined by Assistant Coach Grant White, currently in his second year of coaching at UVa.
